1. Trade between China and Africa

Commodity trade between China and African countries in 2007, the trade volume reached 68 billion USD. 25% up compared with the year 2006.

China gives 26 LDC zero tariff treatment, make it possible for these countries to increase their export to China.

2. FDI

By the end of 2007, China's investment in African countries reached 20 billion USD. In the fields of manufacture, resources development, transportation, infrastructure and agriculture.

3. China's Economic Aid to African Countries.

Ever since 1956, China has provided economic and technical aid to 53 African countries. By the end of 2007, China built over 800 projects, including 137 agriculture projects, 133 infrastructure projects(19 schools, 38 hospitals, 76 giant stadiums)

4. Training Courses.

From 1983 to 2007, 20688 people from African countries have attended all kinds of training courses held by Chinese government. In year 2007, 350 training courses have been held, and 5931 people from African countries attended these courses.
