#### **APRM Youth Mandate**

- I. Assembly/AU/Dec.363(XVII) 2011 Summit Decision requested the African Peer Review Mechanism (APRM) to incorporate the monitoring of the implementation of the African Youth Charter and the plan of Action of the Youth Decade with specific focus on youth social, political and economic development within Member States as also a basis for evaluation
- II. Assembly/AU/Dec. 631 (XXVIII) 2017 called on the APRM to be empowered to track implementation and oversee monitoring and evaluation of the key governance areas on the continent. (APRM Expanded Mandate)





### **APRM Youth 1st Symposium (Ndjamena – Chad)**

APRM held its first International Youth Symposium on 1-2 July 2019, in N'djamena, Chad, under the theme "The Youth as APRM driving force for good governance in Africa".

 Declaration and Outcome Documents called for Mainstreaming of Youth into all APRM processes & an increase in programmes











# Achievements since 2019 Youth Symposium

#### **IV. Milestones**

- APRM Youth Network was established
- Agreement to support AUC Youth Division & AU Youth Envoy
- APRM Secretariat now prioritises the youth in its meetings (Notable increase in youth participation in APRM High Level Meetings)
- APRM Continental Youth Network Established & Network is given space and support
- 3 National Youth Networks are functional (Chad, Mali & Kenya)
- Republic of Namibia Targeted Review on Youth Unemployment
- Revision of the APRM Questionnaire ( Deepening the APRM process ) has a youth tool kit included
- Funding from partners for youth programmes & plans for APRM Youth Desk





## **Recommendations for South African Youth**

- Encourage the South African Focal Points (Department of Public Service and Administration) and the newly elected APRM NGC to start active youth programmes in RSA.
- Establish a national APRM Youth Network (Focal Point here is Mr. Thembinkosi Josopu from the South African Youth Council
- Revisit the 2007 RSA APRM Country Review Report & the Progress Reports before the South Africa 2<sup>nd</sup> Generation Country Review
- Fully participate in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Generation APRM Country Review Process, through advocacy and mobilisation of RSA youth (Prioritise Sub-Urban and Rural Youth)
- Follow up after Country Review & Peer Review (NPoA and Progress Reports)
- Take advantage of the APRM Secretariat based in Midrand
