## Current investments in South Africa



#### Portfolio case study - Candi

Candi has raised more than £1.4 million from over 900 investors via Energise Africa (and £2.5 million including Lendahand) to support the growth of their operations in South Africa and India.

This working capital finance has enabled them to install 2,500 KW of solar capacity providing stable energy supplies for small to medium sized businesses

More than 1,200 tonnes of avoided CO2 emissions will be prevented from entering the atmosphere each year and candi has a further pipeline of 100 MW of installations which they need to finance
