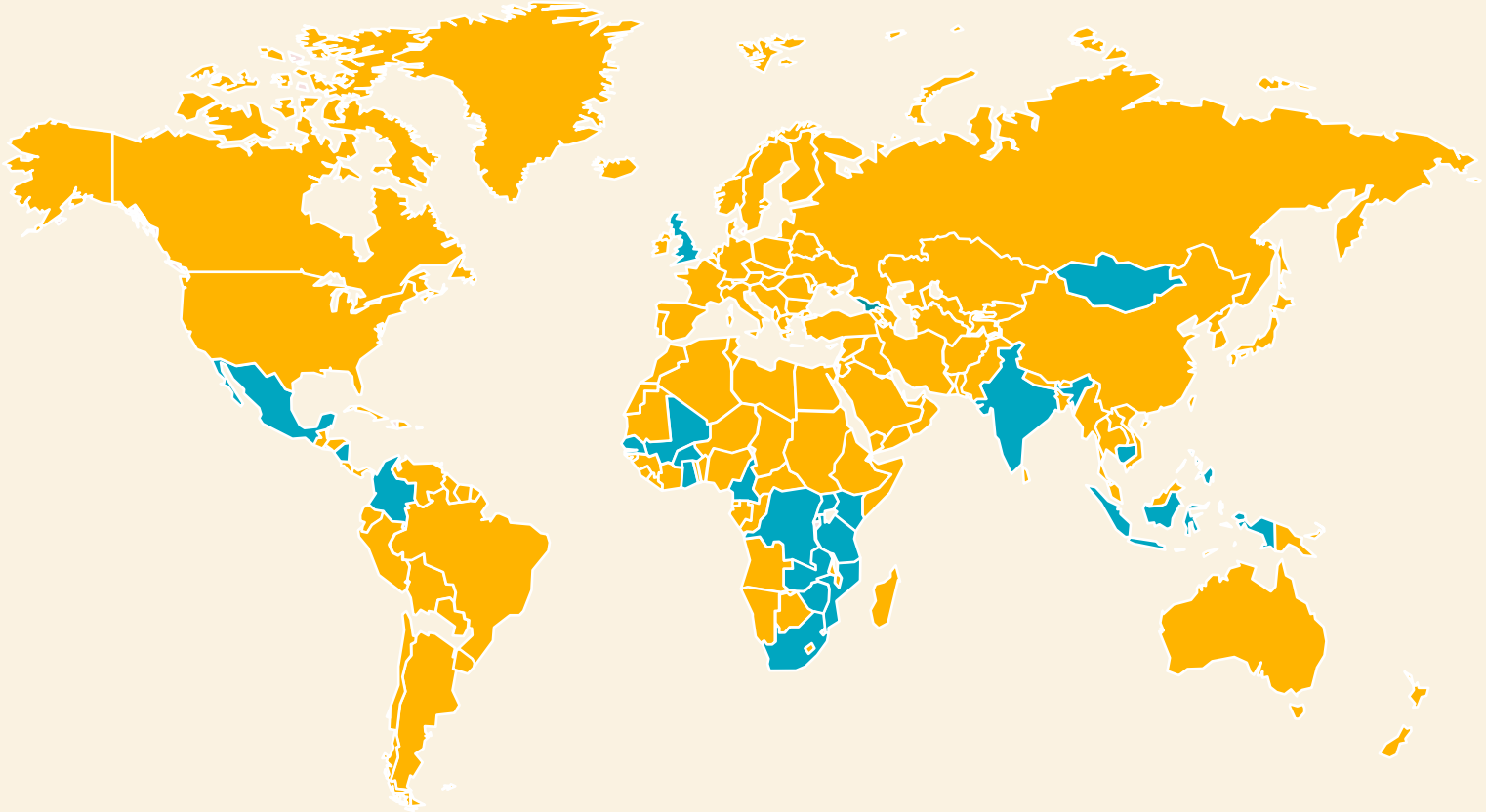

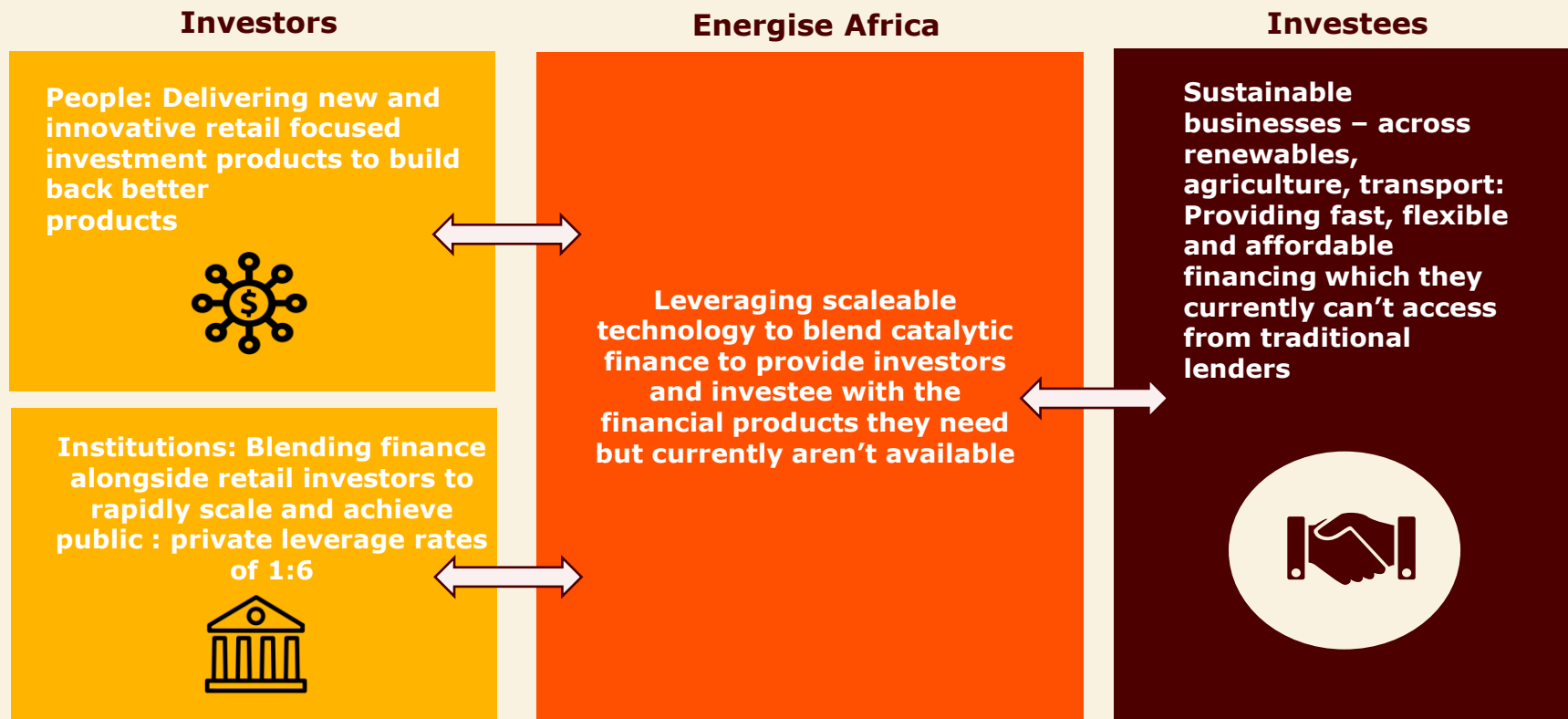
Portfolio case study - Candi

- 
- ✓ Candi has raised more than £1.4 million from over 900 investors via Energise Africa (and £2.5 million including Lendahand) to support the growth of their operations in South Africa and India.
 - ✓ This working capital finance has enabled them to install 2,500 KW of solar capacity providing stable energy supplies for small to medium sized businesses
 - ✓ More than 1,200 tonnes of avoided CO2 emissions will be prevented from entering the atmosphere each year and candi has a further pipeline of 100 MW of installations which they need to finance
