Anthony Butler is Professor of Political Studies at the University of Cape Town. He was educated at St Anne's College, Oxford, and King's College, Cambridge. He has been a fellow of Emmanuel College, Cambridge; Director of the Politics and Administration programme at Birkbeck College, University of London; and Chair in Political Studies at Wits.

His research has focused on the politics of public policy. He has a special interest in black economic empowerment, energy policy, public health, and state reform. He has also made contributions to the study of South African politics, with a focus on the internal politics of the ANC, party modernisation, and political funding.

He is the author of a number of books, including *The Idea of the ANC* (Ohio University Press, 2012), *Contemporary South Africa* (Palgrave Macmillan, 2017) and the biography *Cyril Ramaphosa* (Jacana, 2019).

Butler is a regular columnist for Johannesburg's Business Day newspaper.
